

Introducing a Vial Rounding Program to Help Reduce Drug Waste

OncoHealth's OneUM™ digital platform makes it easy for providers' offices to evaluate and accept an optimization recommendation.

Point32Health is introducing a new vial rounding program to help reduce waste and manage costs, when clinically appropriate. Vial rounding may also reduce a patient's cost exposure.

What is the process? How do I know if vial rounding is appropriate for my patients?

OncoHealth supports plans and providers through OneUM, an easy-to-use digital prior authorization platform that gives providers transparency to plan rules, preferred regimens, and dose recommendations such as vial rounding.

- During case entry, your patient's case will be reviewed by the OneUM platform
- The OneUM algorithms calculate the patient-specific dose using height, weight, and Body Surface Area (BSA)
- You will be provided a vial rounding recommendation if applicable and be prompted to opt-in to the vial rounding opportunity
- For cases submitted by phone review, vial rounding questions will be asked during case entry

OneUM will make a vial rounding recommendation to reduce the number of vials based on the calculated dose if the original requested dose is impacted by no more than 10%. This does not change the clinical case review process for medical necessity.

What medications qualify for vial rounding?

OncoHealth pharmacists, in conjunction with Point32Health, have created a list of medications that are appropriate for vial optimization.

If everything is correct, submit your request. You will not be able to make changes through the portal once submitted. To make corrections, hit Close to go back.



In the sample case above, the requested dose is 850 mg.



Based on the OneUM algorithm, the suggested dose is rounded down to 765 mg, which is a less-than 10% impact and will require **one fewer vial**.



The provider can opt in to accept or reject the change.
