Our Foundation works with community to support, advocate and advance healthier lives for everyone.

In 2023, 21 Connecticut organizations received grants totaling \$938,500.

Highlights:

- \$360,000 three-year general operating grant to **Connecticut Age Well Collaborative** to convene and coordinate a statewide network of partners to support aging, dementia and disability inclusivity in Connecticut.
- \$120,000 three-year general operating grant to **End Hunger Connecticut!** to support outreach, education and advocacy to improve access to healthy food and increase food security.
- \$50,000 two-year general operating grant to **Health Equity Solutions** to advance health equity and address health disparities by dismantling systemic racism through community-led, policy advocacy and systems change.
- \$100,000 two-year general operating grant to **Keep the Promise Coalition** to support community organizing to improve the mental health system and increase community-based services and support.
- \$150,000 two-year general operating grant to **The Arc Connecticut** to advance policies that ensure people with intellectual, development and neurodiverse disabilities live their best lives in communities of their choice.
